About Kassim: I was in the Waldensian Library and showed Pastor Italo Pons a photo of Kassim preparing to preach in Angrogna and one of the librarians jumped to see it, asking: 'Is he the wonderful minister everyone is talking about in Val d'Angrogna?'!

On 31 August the **President** of the Italian Republic **Sergio Mattarella** came on an official visit to Torre Pellice in order to unveil a plaque in honour of Altiero Spinelli (1907–1986) who in 1943, just out of prison, had spoken in the yard of the Muston chemist shop of European Federalism as the only means to prevent another World War. The date is considered as the beginning of the Resistance.

Hoping to see as many of you as possible at Wesley Church, Cambridge in January, I wish everyone a peaceful Christmas!
